BILLING INFORMATION

All water bill payments are due by the tenth (10th) day of the month. A late charge of **\$20.00** will be added to the account if payment is not received by the Corporation on or before the tenth (10th) day of the month.

If the account is not settled in full by the end of the business day on the twenty sixth (26th), the meter will be locked for non-payment on or as soon as reasonable after the twenty sixth (26th) day of the month. A reconnect fee of **\$70.00** plus the account balance will be required to reconnect / unlock any service that has been disconnected / locked due to delinquency.

Accounts turned off due to delinquent status will be turned back on after payment of delinquent bill, during normal work hours of: **7:30 AM to 4:30 PM.**

If the water is required to be turned on after working hours there will be an additional **\$100.00** due for the trip charge. **OPERATOR CAN NOT ACCEPT PAYMENT IN FIELD, PAYMENT MUST BE MADE AT THE OFFICE**

Payment of bill by check returned for insufficient funds or Automatic Draft not covered will cost **\$35.00**, plus you will lose the privilege of payment by check or Automatic Draft for six (6) months minimum.

The Lavon Water Supply Corporation does prosecute HOT CHECK writers.

DROUGHT STAGE 3 (RELAXED) EFFECTIVE APRIL 18, 2012

Although the recent rainstorms helped fill Lake Lavon and Jim Chapman to near or above normal levels, NTMWD still cannot access 28% of the total NTMWD raw water supply from Lake Texoma because of the zebra mussel infestation. Listed below are the guidelines and restrictions.

Lavon Water Supply Corporation's Stage 3 Guidelines & Restrictions limits outside watering to ONE time every week and NO watering between 10:00 AM and 6:00 PM, with an overall 10% reduction in usage.

Beginning, **April 18, 2012** this plan will be in effect and will require all members to follow these **RULES**.

Addresses ending in even numbers water on Saturdays, anytime after 6:00 pm and before 10:00 am.

Addresses ending in odd numbers water on Sundays, anytime after 6:00 pm and before 10:00 am.

1. No washing or rinsing of vehicles by hose except with a hose end cutoff nozzle.
2. Don't water between 10:00 AM and 06:00 PM.; it results in evaporation and waste.
3. Prevent excess watering that causes runoff.
4. Repair broken or misaligned sprinkler heads to avoid waste.
5. Prohibit hosing of paved areas, buildings, or windows. (Pressure washing of impervious surfaces is allowed.)
6. Don't water when it's raining or about to.
7. Existing swimming pools may be drained and refilled.
8. Foundations, new landscaping, new plantings (first year) of shrubs, and trees may be watered for up to two hours on any day by a hand-held hose or a soaker hose.
9. Hydroseeding, hydromulching, and sprigging is allowed.

The 2012 Texas State Water Plan is available at www.twdb.state.tx.us. The State Water Plan is updated every 5 years to ensure that Texas will have enough water to meet it's needs during a drought of record.
